## **Background**

NDEP's Air Program and the GOE have been working with SSG on identifying preliminary emissions reductions measures for CPRG's PCAP development. The intent of the PCAP is to identify near-term, implementation-ready strategies, initiatives, and other projects that aim to reduce greenhouse gases (GHG) emissions from selected sectors. The PCAP relies on input received from interested and affected parties through email submissions, community workshops, and a focus group convening to identify priority measures applicable to the State of Nevada.

A draft PCAP will be made available for comment from February 8 until midnight, February 18, 2024. Access to this draft document can be obtained through NDEP's CPRG

A Comprehensive Climate Action Plan (CCAP) will be due in 2025. The intent of the CCAP is to build upon the PCAP by identifying all GHG sources, sinks, and sectors present in the state and establish near- and long-term reduction strategies. The engagement process for the CCAP will begin later this year. Outreach events are held to establish meaningful engagement with all interested parties, especially low-income and disadvantaged communities, during development. Public and stakeholder comments to improve outreach and engagement efforts are encouraged and always ongoing.
