



PUBLIC NOTICE

The Administrator of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice, under the Nevada Revised Statutes 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive, and under the Nevada Administrative Code 444.570 through 444.7499, inclusive, that the Division has received a request to modify a Permit to a Class III (Industrial Waste) Landfill from the following applicant:

The Administrator is constrained to either issue the modified Permit or deny the request in accordance with NAC 444.641. The Administrator is publishing this notice of intent to issue the modified Permit to the applicant.

The applicant or any interested persons may submit written comments on this proposed action by the Administrator regarding Permit issuance. Written comments must be submitted within 30 days after the date that this notice is issued, no later than 5:00 pm on May 20 2024 to:

The Draft Permit, Fact Sheet and application are available for review at the above address and required by NAC 444.641(3a) to be on the NDEP website at <https://ndep.nv.gov/posts>. A statement responding to all comments received will be issued pursuant to NAC 444.6415. Copies of the statement will be sent to the applicant, person(s) who submitted written comments, and all other persons who specifically request, in writing, a copy of the statement. A copy of the statement will be made available for public viewing at the location listed above. The Administrator may extend the period for public comment as necessary, or schedule a public hearing, if requested, or due to significant public interest.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.

Within 30 days after the end of the public review period, the Administrator will either issue or deny the Permit modification, or may modify, or place conditions on, the modified Permit issued in accordance with NAC 444.6425.
