NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a revision of Class II Air Quality Operating Permit, AP2869-3847.01 (FIN A1107) from the following applicant:

New Rise Renewables Reno Renewable Naphtha and SAF Processing Plant 1285 Baring Boulevard, #716 Sparks, NV 89434

New Rise Renewables Reno (NRRR) – Renewable Naphtha and SAF Processing Plant is located in the Tahoe-Reno Industrial Center at 611 Peru Drive, McCarran, Nevada. The project is located in all or portions of Section 33, Township 20 N, Range 22 E, M.D.B.&M.

NRRR owns and operates an existing former petrochemical turned renewable fuel plant. NRRR is currently permitted to produce renewable diesel but is proposing to manufacture sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) and renewable naptha (RN) that is converted from distillers' plant-based oil non-food renewable feedstock. A hydrotreating (hydrodeoxygenation) process (hydrogen at elevated temperature and pressure in the presence of a catalyst) is used to remove undesirable characteristics before being marketed as SAF and RN. The revised permit will allow the plant to transload to rail or truck up to 39,091,500 gallons of SAF per year and 6,898,500 gallons of RN per year.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue the proposed Class II Air Quality Operating Permit based on a review of the information submitted. A copy of this document, the draft permit, and the Director's Review will be available for public inspection at http://ndep.nv.gov/posts.
